Larry Shackley is a full-time composer and editor from Columbia, South Carolina. From 1995–2007, he taught and directed the music program at Columbia International University in Columbia, South Carolina. Prior to that, he worked for several years at Moody Broadcasting in Chicago, creating original music and producing radio programs.

Mike Springer maintains an active schedule as a teacher, composer/arranger, pianist and adjudicator in the Dallas, Texas area. His students have won top prizes in many competitions in the fields of performance and composition. Mr. Springer has composed and arranged extensively for piano, electronic media (MIDI), vocal ensemble, and wind ensemble. As a composer for educational piano music, he has had several pieces selected for the National Federation of Music Clubs list. Mr. Springer is an accomplished performer in classical and jazz idioms.
